**Please note**

The slope and rescue services only supervise and control the marked and open slopes! Downhill runs are closed outside the railway operating hours and are not protected against dangers such as avalanche dispersion or snow groomers with cable winches! DANGER!

**Security notice**

The area outside the marked and groomed slopes is considered to be an off-piste snow-sport area. It is neither marked nor protected against Alpine dangers.

**Information**

All slopes are marked on both sides by orange posts, the level of difficulty and their number.

**10 FIS Rules**

1. Do not endanger or prejudice others.
2. Adapt your speed and manner of skiing or snowboarding to your personal ability and the prevailing conditions.
3. Do not choose a route that endangers skiers or snowboarders ahead.
4. When you overtake, leave enough space for the others.
5. Look up the slope before entering a run.
6. Only stop on the edge of the slope where visibility is good.
7. Only climb or descend on foot on the side of the slope.
8. Respect all signs and markings.
9. Provide help when it is needed, notify the rescue service.
10. Persons involved in an accident and witnesses: provide your personal data.
